



## Responsibilities of Parents, Students & Families at the Ryan Center

At St. Alphonsus, our Ryan Center, is a beautiful facility and is in excellent condition. Students and all visitors have a responsibility to ensure it remains that way. Therefore, the following rules apply to all visitors:

- **No food, drinks, or gum** is permitted in the gym. However, players may have water or sports beverages in closed plastic bottles, and these must be kept in the plastic holders behind their benches.
- **No smoking or other tobacco products** are permitted in the facility.
- Players and cheerleaders must carry their playing shoes into the gym. Shoes worn to the gym are not permitted on the gym floor; this applies to all activities: practices, games, and class and to everyone permitted on the court.
- Only soft rubber heeled and soled shoes are permitted on the gym floor.
- During games, only coaches, players, and officials are permitted on the court. Spectators, including students and their families, are not allowed on the court.
- During practices or games, only coaches or officials are permitted on the stage. Spectators and students are not permitted there.
- During after school hours no one may enter the school from the gym.
- Only balls provided by St. Alphonsus may be used; no outside balls.
- All events involving children must be supervised by an adult.
- Parents are responsible for damage caused by their children.
- Students must show positive attitudes towards their teammates, and display good sportsmanship towards their opponents.
- Spirit signs may be placed on the walls with blue masking tape, only. The tape is stored in the concession stand.
